His recent successes include a successful trial, a variety of summary judgments, and an injunction preventing competition for two years by two employees who had not signed a non-compete agreement. Barry has successfully convinced opposing lawyers to drop cases wrongfully brought against clients of the firm without motion. He led a team that obtained the dismissal of an FLSA collective action for plaintiff's failure to observe procedural requirements of the FLSA. Barry has obtained sanctions of over \$17,000 against a plaintiff for refusing to proceed to trial on the date set by the court. The Court of Appeals affirmed that order. He has tried several cases since joining Jackson Lewis ten years ago, and before. However, most of his successes involve confidential information that cannot be disclosed.

While attending law school, Barry received three American Jurisprudence awards, including Civil Procedure and Contracts.
