A PROGRAM FOR COLLEGE STUDENT-ATHLETES

In the world of college sports, a single incident can lead to the end of an athlete's sports career, suspension or expulsion, loss of a scholarship, or criminal or civil liability. Jackson Lewis' Collegiate and Professional Sports Group has developed a multimedia program to proactively address the potential consequences of certain actions and decisions by collegiate athletes. This thought-provoking presentation encourages students to reflect on their attitudes and behaviors in connection with dating, respect for fellow students, drug and alcohol use, and gambling, among other things. We also address issues related to dealing with agents, advisors and professional sports teams, and the potential pitfalls of social media use. During an interactive question and answer session, we discuss how specific instances in which student-athletes can get themselves into trouble may be appropriately handed.

These presentations can be tailored to single-sport teams or to all student athletes (male and female) from every sport. Attendance and participation by coaches, compliance officers, Title IX coordinators, university counsel and other staff is welcome and encouraged.
